


Welcome to the Guest House of the University of Bayreuth

Opening times

The buildings of the University of Bayreuth are in general open at the times given below:

Campus & Geschwister-Scholl-Platz: Monday to Friday 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The University of Bayreuth was built in 1975 and was established as the seventh Bayarian state university. The first degree courses offered at the University were biology and chemistry along with different kinds of teacher-training courses for the subjects mathematics, physics and sports.

Today's profile is characterized by a differentiation into research fields that are already internationally visible and are characterized by a high degree of thematic and programmatic coherence ("Advanced Fields"), and into new interdisciplinary research foci that are in the early stages of a dynamic development identified as sustainable by responding to a socially relevant research need ("Emerging Fields").

The "Glashaus" is well worth a visit.

It is located between the GEO building and the new NW III building in the west of the university campus. In the past, the Glasshouse was also used as a canteen. Behind the building, you can lie in the meadow in summer or relax on the forecourt. In winter you can warm up inside with tea or mulled wine at tables or at the bar.

In the evenings there are often bands on stage and you can have a good time on the dance floor.

Another attraction located on the area of the University is the Ecological-Botanical Garden ("Ökologischer-Botanischer Garten").

It offers a unique botanical journey around the world in just a few hours. Here you can experience around 12,000 plant species in natural habitats. The ÖBG serves teaching and research, the preservation of endangered plant and animal species and the public for education and recreation.

House rules

On properties administered by the University, the following activities require **authorization**:

The display of **postings** or **placards**, as well as the distribution of **leaflets** or **flyers**,

The organising of assemblages or elections,

The setting up of **information or sales stands**, as well as any other type of marketing of goods or the collecting of orders

Also, **Smoking** is strictly forbidden in the interior rooms of buildings, as well as bringing **food and drink** into libraries and classrooms.

Apart from the cleaning staff taking care of the apartment in regular intervals, our guests are also requested keep it clean. Cleaning products are provided in every room.

In the basement you can find the washing machines along with the dryers which you can use for a small fee.

Please note that our guests are strongly requested not to do their laundry in their rooms!


Please air your room regularly.

Disposal the rubbish

When moving out of your room, **cupboards and war-drobes have to be cleaned out.**

Food and containers (cans, bottles,...) have to be disposed.







There are different kinds of waste bins:



How to get from A to B

The guest house is located in the south of Bayreuth in the Birken precinct.

The facilities of the University as well as the city centre are easily accessible from there on foot or by public transport.

There is also a supermarket and a bakery in the immediate vicinity. The Hofgarten (city park) and the city centre can be reached on foot in about 15 minutes.

Public transport – Bus

In close proximity to the guest house there are two bus stops:

Bayreuth Klopstockstraße and Bayreuth Birkenstraße.

If you want to get to the **university** take **line 304** starting at either one of the stops above.

The QR code on the right will take you to the website of the VGN, the public transportation system of Greater Nuremberg where you can have a look at the different bus routes including departure and arrival times.

Taxi

When taking a taxi to travel, the central agency is "Taxi Union Bayreuth e.G", which is available 24 hours a day.



Train

The central station of Bayreuth is at Bahnhofstr. 20, 95444 Bayreuth.
